Some of the issues being reviewed include agricultural/rural issues, housing, settlement areas, special policy areas, municipal servicing, environmental policies, cultural heritage policies and administrative issues. Input received at the meeting will be considered by Council in the preparation of the amendment to implement revisions to the Official Plan.
