

NOTICE OF MEETING
regarding a Proposed Amendment
to the North Middlesex Official Plan

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Municipality of North Middlesex will hold the following statutory meetings:

April 1st, 2010 Statutory Open House – Council Chambers
2:00 – 4:00 p.m.

April 12, 2010 Statutory Public Meeting – Council Chambers
8:00 p.m.

The purpose of this Amendment is to implement changes to the North Middlesex Official Plan further to the five year review project initiated in 2009. Pursuant to Section 26 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13 a municipality is required to review its official plan not less frequently than every five years after it comes into effect. Further, prior to revising its official plan a municipality is required to consult with the approval authority and the prescribed bodies as to revisions that may be required and to hold a special council meeting open to the public to discuss the revisions that may be required. The Municipality of North Middlesex has undertaken the required consultation and held a special council meeting to present recommended revisions to the official plan on December 2, 2009.

This amendment will generally update existing policies related to agriculture, natural environment, housing and procedural matters to ensure consistency with the Provincial Policy Statement and conformity with the County of Middlesex Official Plan. This amendment also includes changes of a technical nature and updates with respect to changes to the Planning Act which came into force in 2007.

Official Plan Amendment No. 3 pertains to all lands within the Municipality of North Middlesex

ANY PERSON may attend the meetings and/or make written or verbal representation.

If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of Municipality of North Middlesex in respect of the proposed official plan amendment does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of North Middlesex before the proposed official amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed official plan amendment you must make a written request to the Municipality of North Middlesex, 229 Parkhill Main Street, Parkhill Ont NOM 2K0

A copy of the proposed amendment, prepared by the Municipal Planning Consultant, was accepted by Council on March 1, 2010 and will be available at the Main Office in Parkhill during regular office hours. The amendment can also be viewed on our website at www.northmiddlesex.on.ca
