

MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH MIDDLESEX BY-LAW 64 OF 2017 BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS:

- A) Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c 25, as amended or replaced (hereafter referred to as the "Municipal Act") provides that a lower-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public within its sphere of jurisdiction;
- B) Section 11(2) in paragraph 7 of the *Municipal Act* provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws with respect to services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide under subsection (1);
- C) Section 391 of the *Municipal Act* provides that:

without limiting sections 9 and 11, a municipality and a local board may pass bylaws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

- i. For services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it
- ii. For costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and
- iii. For the use of its property including property under its control;
 - such fees and charges may include the costs of administration, enforcement, and the establishment, acquisition and replacement of capital assets; and
 - such fees or charges are payable regardless of whether or not it is mandatory for the municipality to do the service or activity or pay costs to allow the use of its property.
- D) Section 398(1) of the *Municipal Act* provides that where fees and charges are imposed by a municipality on a person, the fee or charge is a debt owing to the municipality;

- E) Section 446 of the *Municipal Act* provides that where a person is required to do a matter or thing, the costs to do the matter or thing is an expense owing to the municipality;
- F) The Council of the Municipality is able to determine the services or things that are necessary or desirable for the public and impose fees and charges for services or activities, costs payable by the municipality and the use of its property pursuant to the aforementioned authorities.
- G) Pursuant to the *Planning Act,* R.S.O 1990, c.P.13 a municipality may establish fees for the processing of applications;
- H) Pursuant to the *Building Code Act, 1992* S.O. 1992 c.23 a municipality may establish fees for the processing of applications;
- I) Pursuant to section 425 of the *Municipal Act*, a municipality may pass by-laws providing that a person who contravenes a by-law of the municipality passed under that Act is guilty of an offence;
- J) The Council of the Municipality of North Middlesex deems it expedient and desirable to set user fees and charges for services provided by the Municipality and has given notice of its intent to establish user fees and charges in this bylaw.
- K) Subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act* provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED THAT the Council of the Municipality of North Middlesex establishes the fees and charges as set out in the attached as follows:

1. In this by-law:

"Municipality" means the Corporation of the Municipality of North Middlesex.

2. The Schedules to this By-law establish and impose Fees and Charges in accordance with sections 391 and 394 of the *Municipal Act*, Section 7 of the *Building Code Act*, S.O. 1992, c.23 and Sections 42(6), 53(13) and 69(1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.

- 3. The fees and charges established by this by-law shall be due and payable in full without discount by cheque, cash or debit at the time of submitting an application or prior to the request for service.
- 4. The fees and charges imposed by this By-law constitute a debt owing to the Municipality, as set out in section 398 of the *Municipal Act*.
- 5. That any destruction of municipal property constitutes a use of the municipal property or service contemplated by section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 and a fee or charge is imposed as set out in Schedule "A".
- 6. Where a fee or charge is imposed it shall be imposed upon the person or party who caused the activity or event requiring a fee or charge to be imposed and the owner(s) of the property requiring the fee or charge to be imposed on a joint and several basis.
- 7. The Treasurer of the Municipality may add the fees and charges imposed by this by-law pursuant to section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* to the tax roll in the same manner as municipal taxes, as set out in section 398 and 446 of the Municipal Act or pursuant to any other statutory authority.
- 8. Fees or charges imposed by this by-law that are subject to interest, as set out in the *Municipal Act*.
- 9. Any contravention of this by-law constitutes an offence;
- 10. That the following By-laws and/or Schedules are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this By-law: By-Law #54 of 2015, By-law #20 of 2013, By-law #21 of 2013, By-law #58 of 2013, By-law #19 of 2013 Schedule A only, By-law #43 of 2004 Schedule D only and the Cemetery Price List dated June 4, 2014 only and By-law 67 of 2016
