

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

QUEEN STREET AILSA CRAIG REHABILITATION WEST CORNER DRIVE TO FUTURE MARY STREET

As part of the overall plan to improve the drinking water distribution system within the community of Ailsa Craig, the Municipality of North Middlesex is intending to replace and upgrade the existing watermain on Queen Street from the site of the new Elevated Storage Facility to the future Mary Street. As part of this Project, the existing sanitary sewer between Mary Street and Annie Ada Shipley Street will also be upgraded to accommodate planned growth in the community. This Project is being planned as a Schedule A+ undertaking under the Municipal Class EA Planning Process and, as such, is Pre-Approved under the Environmental Assessment Act.

You are invited to attend a Public Open House to learn more about the Project, and to discuss your construction related concerns about this Project. Opportunities to discuss potential modifications to the roadway will also be discussed. Staff from the Municipality and the Engineering Consultant will be in attendance to receive your comments and to discuss your concerns.
