PARKHILL MAIN STREET REHABILITATION ELGINFIELD ROAD TO PARKHILL DRIVE

As part of the overall plan to improve the drinking water distribution system within the community of Parkhill, the Municipality of North Middlesex is intending to replace and upgrade the existing watermain on Parkhill Main Street from Elginfield Road to Parkhill Drive, and along Elginfield Road from Parkhill Main Street to West Park Drive. This Project is being planned as a Schedule A+ undertaking under the Municipal Class EA Planning Process and, as such, is Pre-Approved under the Environmental Assessment Act.

You are invited to attend a Public Open House to learn more about the Project, and to discuss your construction related concerns about this Project. Opportunities to discuss potential modifications to the roadway will also be discussed. Staff from the Municipality and the Engineering Consultant will be in attendance to receive your comments and to discuss your concerns.
