



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

Parkhill Distribution System Improvements – Construction Notice

The Municipality of North Middlesex (North Middlesex) has recently executed a contract with Bre-Ex Construction Inc. (Contractor) of London to complete the construction of the Parkhill Distribution System Improvements project. This project includes construction of a new watermain on Parkhill Main Street from Parkhill Drive to Elginfield Road, and along Elginfield Road/Elliot Drive from Parkhill Main Street to West Park Drive, as well as replacement of all water service connections, connections to the existing water distribution system on all side streets, and minor upgrades to the existing sanitary sewer at Mill Street and Hastings Street. Restoration will include resurfacing of Parkhill Main Street with new sidewalks, curbs and pavement.

Construction is anticipated to start the week of **October 17th, 2022**, with completion by the summer of 2023. The Contractor intends to work through the winter, subject to suitable weather conditions. It is anticipated that the Contractor will work during regular working hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Some after-hours or weekend work may be required.

Construction of this Project is planned to be staged, with full road closures permitted in each stage of construction. Local and emergency access will be maintained at all times. Residents and businesses can expect regular truck traffic, potential vibration from construction equipment and may also have minor disruptions to their water service. Any planned disruptions to water service will be communicated a minimum of 48 hours in advance separately to each affected resident or business.
