Court of Revision was held on July 13, 2022 in person at the Municipal Office Council Chambers to consider any appeals under Section 46 of the Drainage Act.

Ms. Sadler presented an overview of the process taken to date for this drain according to the Drainage Act.

The Engineers Letter Report dated April 22, 2022 from Spriet Associates Engineers & Architects was provided to all affected landowners.

A request to appeal has been received. The Drainage Superintendent explained that although there is a minimum ten day period prior to the meeting in which to appeal, an appeal had been received today. She explained that, given the timing of the appeal, it is within the authority of the Court of Revision to hear the appeal.

KEOGH/CORNELISSEN: That the Court of Revision hear the appeal from owner Eric Spiessens.

Eric Spiessens appealed his assessment and explained to the Court that the Drain does not require improvement. He stated he has no benefit from the Drain. He asked the Court that the assessment assigned to his property be reduced to zero.


The Engineer was asked for comment on the appeal and review the report and the assigned assessments. The Engineer reviewed his report and explained the rationale regarding the assessments.


